To register for DDYB, please complete the steps below in the order presented.  
See DDYB 2010 information on the reverse side of this sheet

- Step 1 Check the Boundaries Map.
  - Is your home zip code 36526?
  - If yes, do you live within the boundary?
  - If you answered "No" to either question above, please check with a DDYB representative before proceeding.
  
- Step 2 Complete the registration form (please print hard). DO NOT tear the registration form apart.  
We'll do that at checkout.
  - If you have NOT previously participated in DDYB, you must present a valid birth certificate (we will make a copy)
  
- Step 3 Select a shirt size at the fitting table.
  - Note if the shirt size is Youth or and Adult size. Enter the size on your registration form (YL, YS, AL, AS, etc.)
  
- Step 4 Proceed to your commission to register.
  - League Age is based on age at May 1, 2010.
    - Age 5 & 6 - Register with the T-Ball Commissioner
    - Age 7 & 8 - Register with the Peanut Commissioner
    - Age 9 & 10 - Register with the Minor Commissioner
    - Age 11 & 12 - Register with the O-Zone Commissioner
  
- Step 5 Stop by the Sponsorship Table!!
  
- Step 6 Time to Pay! Proceed to the checkout table. Checks should be made out to DDYB."Fees are 1<sup>st</sup> child \$90, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$80, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$60.
